EXAMINATIONS CONDUCTED BY THE COLLEGE :

At least two Unit Tests for all classes from Higher Secondary to TDC (1+1+1) level will be held during the year.

Two sessional exam. will be held for the first year in each semester of TDC.

EXAMINATION RULES :

- A Student must attend at least 75% of classes held in each subject/paper during the academic session. For TDC students, Internal Assessment is compulsory as per G.U. rules.**
- All students must appear in all the examination conducted by the college during an academic year. Pass marks for all the college examination is as laid down by AHSEC/G.U. A student must pass all subjects in the Unit Tests/ Terminal examinations held in the college.
- Students must satisfy the Principal in all respect of regularity in class attendance and study, discipline, behavior and good conduct.
- The eligibility for appearing at the final examination with subjects having practical will be decided by the concerned Heads of the department on the basis of their regularity and performance.

INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL (IQAC) :

To develop an action plan for the academic year, to interact with Students / Management / Society, to assess and elicit suggestions / recommendation in important areas like introducing need based academic programmes, improving infrastructural facilities etc. and to share best practices with the others, Rangia College has an Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). the students and teachers use the library regularly.
